Input cell	An entry cell for participants
Calculated cell	A cell containing a formula
Main results	A cell which also contains a formula and generates a key outcome

The structure of the Excel sheet is protected to avoid (accidental) change.

However, all cells are unlocked, including those containing formulas and may be changed if necessary.

Most cells are filled with – or %. This allows a separation between cells that are empty (no value) and cells that contain 0 (zero).

Participants are requested to employ this separation as well.

Experience that updates to the template are sometimes required.

Two ways to update: Use a provided update tool which keeps data already inputted, or manually transfer to new template.
