Overview Implementation of IORP II – Title IV Disclosure



- 1. <u>EIOPA Report on the Pension Benefit Statement</u> approved in the September 2018 BoS
 - o OPSG provided comments in August and EIOPA gave its feedback in October
 - o November <u>news item</u>
- 2. <u>EIOPA Report on Other information to be provided to prospective and current members</u> approved in the January 2019 BoS
 - o OPSG provided its Advice in December and EIOPA gave its reasoned feedback in March
 - o March news item



Progress on the PBS designs

PBS Designs: length



Two versions of the PBS:

- 1. A "Basic" PBS with the following sections:
 - Personal data
 - II. Amount accumulated in the pension pot
 - III. Pension projection with 3 scenarios
 - IV. Overview changes in the last year
 - V. "Nudging" section
 - VI. Overview pension plan features

Intended to cover all the mandatory elements of the PBS <u>and</u> nudge the member towards an assessment of his/her financial situation.

2. An "Extended" PBS:

Intended to go beyond the mandatory elements of the PBS: more insight on the breakdown of the contributions (by month) and an expanded nudging section

PBS Designs: layout



Layout - Two design layouts of the PBS:

Version 1	Version 2
Perceived as more "serious"	Perceived as more "fun"
Sober colours	Vivid colours
Images (purse, bills, coins, pig, etc.) to represent concepts (contributions, return, value)	Symbols (rocking chair, bicycle) to send a message (e.g. retirement scenarios)
Diagram to show accumulation	Diagram to show evolution
Cost breakdown – nature of costs (admin., invest., transact., etc.)	Cost breakdown – source of costs to cover & periodicity (entry costs, cost withheld from assets, etc.)

Targeted consultation



- What? 5 mock-ups of the PBS designs:
 - o Version 1: basic + extended
 - o Version 2: basic (Rocking chair, Purse) + extended
- How? Through an on-line EU-Survey
 - OPSG members are invited to group their response/s (either as a whole or by category: beneficiaries, industry, etc.)
 - o NCAs and targeted stakeholders will also be invited to respond
- When? The survey will be launched in June and open circa 2-3 weeks
- Responses will feed into the refinement of the PBS designs
