
Arbitration Court at the PFSA

Enacted on 31 March 2008 on the basis of the Financial Market Supervision Act Arbitration Centre 40 arbitrators (20 to 40) at least 1/3: barristers, solicitors, Ph.D. in law Mediation Centre 21 mediators (no less than 15)


Procedure of mediation

- Request for mediation
 - □ fee: 50 PLN (~ 12 €)
 - proposal of the mediator
- Consent (or lack of consent)
 - proposal of the mediator
- One mediator (two mediators in special cases)
 - □ remuneration: 500 PLN (~ 120 €)
 - > the difference covered by the PFSA from its budget
- □ Place:
 - Mediation Centre
 - □ remote (telcom)

Conclusions

□ Main concerns:

- dependent on the PFSA
- information could be used by the PFSA
- > dispelled full independence and confidenciality confirmed

Development:

- □ High competence and qualifications of mediators
- Practical knowledge of the market
- Promotional actions
 - constant campaigns in media, courts and other institutions
 - seminars, films etc.
- **D** Public awards:
 - Financial institution amicable to mediations
 - Ambassador of mediations on the financial market
