Why Guidelines on Colleges of Supervisors?

o Art 248.6 SII Directive (OMDII) requires EIOPA to issue guidelines on the operational functioning of colleges

What are the aims of the guidelines?

- Specify responsibilities of college members and participants
- o Clarify and enhance the cooperation between competent supervisory authorities for cross-border groups
- o Enhance information-sharing among supervisors and communication to the group
- o Enhance the single market level playing field by ensuring a consistent approach among colleges

Main features of the guidelines □□□□

The guidelines deal with processes for:

- o Establishment of the College of Supervisors
- o Initial meeting of the College
- o On-going functioning of the College
- o Joint and local examinations
- o Delegations of tasks

Annexes within the guidelines provide:

- o A Coordination Arrangements Template
- o An Emergency Plan Template
- A List of ratios and selected data to be exchanged within colleges

Benefits of the guidelines for supervisors and policyholders



Supervisors mainly benefit from:

- o A step-by-step approach to set-up colleges
- o A list of ratios and selected data to be exchanged on a regular basis for improving information exchange
- o A shared view on the risks of the group as part of the supervisory review process
- o Templates to prepare the Coordination Arrangements and the Emergency Plan

Supervisors and Policyholders benefit from:

- o Detection of potential serious financial disturbances at an early stage
- o Coordination of emergency actions in adverse situations

Benefits of the guidelines for groups



Facilitate communication with supervisors by:

- o Organising regular meetings
- o Coordinating information requests to avoid duplications

Ensure equal treatment of groups through:

- o Standardisation of information requests within colleges
- o Facilitate instruction of applications and approval process

Ensure proportionate treatment of groups by:

- o Providing a template for coordination arrangements that may be adapted to specific situations when justified, i.e. timeframes
- o Providing a list of ratios and selected data that may be adapted to specific situations when justified
