- Members supported the suggested strategic topics for discussion during the EIOPA Strategy Day: sustainable finance and supervisory convergence.
- With regard to sustainable finance, there was a general desire for greater clarity of the meaning of the concepts referred to on the concrete added value that supervisors can bring to the discussion.
- With regard to Supervisory Convergence, MB agreed to focus on the discussion on implementation, monitoring and measuring.

Action points:

- COM to liaise with EIOPA ahead of COM's expected call for advice and/or invitation to issue an opinion on assessment of prudential rules on sustainable investment.
- EIOPA to approach some MB members to help to lead the discussions in Strategy Day.

5.1. EIOPA's initiative on pensions data

• Members appreciated the amendments and further progress made in relation to the proposals for EIOPA's pension data needs and were supportive of the initiative.

Action points:

- EIOPA to clarify the voluntary reporting of non- Institutions for Occupational Retirement Provision (IORP) data to ensure data is distinguishable from IORP data.
- EIOPA to include in the documents to be submitted to BoS an enhanced explanation of the needs for individual data and the reasons for the European Central Bank (ECB) requirements.

Conclusions:

- Management Board welcomed the presentation on the methodology for the first report, noted that the suggested approach is a good starting point and agreed that all the caveats of the approach (implementation of Packaged Retail and Insurancebased Investment Products (PRIIPs)) as well as data comparability limitations (products with profit participation and personal pensions) should be highlighted in the report.
- The first report might not bring definitive conclusions on the costs and performance levels of retail products, but it will identify the gaps and limitations currently encountered to ensure meaningful comparisons. The methodology will be improved in subsequent iterations.

Action points:

- EIOPA to test the Industry questionnaire with few undertakings.
- Board of Supervisors to discuss and approve the Methodology in its April meeting.
